Samuel GARRATT arrived at Tasmania on ship "Great Tasmania" on 16 April 1863 age 35 occupation chain-smith along with his wife Elizabeth age 32 years and 2 children James age 11 and William age 10 months. The ship left Liverpool on 08 December 1862. They were becalmed for 17 days and nearly wrecked 500 miles off course and arrived at Melbourne on 26 March 1863 and Hobart on 16 April 1863. The bounty for the trip was £16 per adult £8 for James and £4 for William making a total of £44.0s.0d.

Samuel worked for his half-brother Benjamin (a pardoned convict) who had a blacksmith shop in Exton Westbury Tasmania Australia. Articles that appeared in the Launceston Examiner newspaper stated that Samuel worked for his half-brother for some years.

In the publication "Roots and Branches" by Errol LEA-SCARLETT (1979) chapter on Drawing up a Pedigree page 35 reads:

*Photograph of a tombstone inscription:* Erected by Samuel GARRETT in memory of his beloved wife, Ann, born at Roscrea, Tipperary, Ireland, died at Sydney 23 May 1883 aged 41 years. Pasted onto the back of this photograph was a newspaper cutting referring to the death in May 1883 of Mrs Samuel GARRETT, eldest daughter of the late Rody CAHILL, aged 41, at her residence, 107 Lower George Street, Sydney. She was interred at the Petersham cemetery.

A check of the Petersham Cemetery registers confirmed that Ann GARRATT (sic) of George Street Sydney died May 1883 but on the 24<sup>th</sup> according to the entry aged forty-one

Note I do not think this is our Samuel GARRETT family?
