My Dear Cousin

It is with deep regret I have to inform you of the death of my dear husband. I sent from the paper with the account of death if you have got it, as I did not feel I could write you before. It has made me feel so ill, the sudden fright, it was too dreadful. He was feeling so much better and had enjoyed his food that day. It does seem rather strange my Brothers dear wife to be taken from him in the same way, but it was to be. We are not our own millers but it seems very hard to in such a way. Trusting this will find yourself and cousin William in good health. I have not heard from cousin Lizzy lately. I hope she and her family are going on all right. I wish it was not so far. I should like to drop to see you all but it is too far for me. Hope to hear from you soon again. Trade is very quiet very where. Just slow. I hope they will be better with my trouble. I have forgotten if I have told you My Brother has married our cousin Jimmie Bidiford. She has been a widow 8 years and he was so bothered with that by himself he had been married 5 weeks when my dear Husband died.
