- To be 15 at the battle of the Nile is very young and would have been rated as Ordinary Seaman (not Petty Officer) or Boy or Landsman.
- Joseph does not appear on the list of those from the Minotaur who were awarded the Naval General Service Medal with Nile clasp, which was issued in 1849, which leads to think that Joseph was not alive in 1849.
- If Joseph Olive was present from September 1796 as indicated in the muster, he would have been present during the Spithead mutiny in April-May 1797. The Minotaur was one of the ships involved

The Victory Nile Medal 01 August 1798 was awarded to <u>Joseph OLIVE</u> on the "Minotaur". The bronze gilt indicating he was a Petty Officer. The medal belongs to one of his descendants and I have an image of the medal.

Alexander Davidson was appointed by Nelson as sole prize agent for the captured ships after the battle of the Nile. He had this medal struck at Matthew Boulton's Birmingham mint and presented it to all who took part in the action – in gold to Nelson, in silver to Lieutenants and warrants officers, in gilt metal for petty officers, and to seaman and marines in copper.

Observe: on a rock near the sea, Peace is standing holding in her hand an olive branch and supporting with her left hand a medallion of Nelson, an anchor behind her. Legend: 'REAR-ADMIRAL LORD NELSON OF THE NILE'. Inscription: 'EUROPE'S HOPE AND BRITIAN'S GLORY". Below: 'C.H.K.' (c H Kuchler). Reverse: view of Abourkir Bay, the English fleet going into action, the French at anchor. Legend: "ALMIGHTY GOD HAS BLESSED HIS MAJESTY'S ARMS'. Exergue: VICTORY OF THE NILE AUGUST 1 1798". Above (left) "M.B. KUCHLER. FEC". Edge 'FROM ALEXR DAVIDSON, ESQR. ST JAMES;S SQUARE = A TRIBUTE OF REGARD'. The topography on the reverse of the medal shows the Aboukir promontory on he eastern rather than the western side of the bay.
