Mary Ann SHERRY was born on 28 October 1881 at East Tamaki Auckland New Zealand. She was the sixth child born to Mary (Mary Ann Jane) formerly WINEPRESS age 28 years born Howick and John SHERRY aged 40 years born Manchester England occupation Labourer. John SHERRY father of East Tamaki registered the birth on 11 November 1881. The registrar was John M Nayour.

There was a flu epidemic in 1918 and it weakened many a strong person.

Thomas Edward BOYLE age 42 years born Papakura Auckland occupation Carter died on the 18 November 1918 at Vermont Street Hospital, Auckland from Cracroft Street Parnell. Cause of death was Influenza 2 days and Pneumonia as certified by Dr Robertson who saw him last on 18 November 1918. Thomas was buried on 20 November at the Waikaraka cemetery Auckland by Roman Catholic minister Rev W H Mahoney. Thomas was age 29 when he married Jane FAHEY in Auckland. His living issue were recorded as 2 male aged 11 & 5 and 2 females aged 7 & 3 years. Thomas' widow recorded as Jane was aged 36 years at the time of his death and his parents were recorded as Jane FAHEY and James BOYLE occupation Labourer. M Little was authorised in writing by C Little undertaker Auckland to registered the death on 22 November 1918. The registrar was J Culp[an[sic].
