Isabella Margaret DE THIERRY was born 23 June 1863 Hobson Park Parnell Auckland. Her parents were Mary NYE and Charles Thomas Frederick DE THIERRY.

Isabella DE THIERRY had a daughter Maggie DE THIERRY born 1882 in New Zealand. There are no details regarding the father. I do not know if this is the daughter of Isabella Margaret De Thierry.

George BROADFOOT aged 67 years a widower occupation Ship-rigger was recorded on 6 May 1922 in Auckland Hospital records as having Cardiac Disease. His address was c/- Mrs FERGUSON, 23 Wakefield Street, City. It was recorded that he dwelled in the district for 49 years and been in the dominion also 49 years. This would make his arrival in New Zealand around 1873. His friend was Alexander GOUK, (made out will) Wapiti Avenue, One Tree

Hill. George's brother-in-law, Baron F James DE THIERRY occupation Builder of 80 Burnley Terrace, Kingsland, Auckland. George's sister was Margaret MILLIGAN wife of John K MILLIGANE in Scotland.
