Gerard SAMPSON was a Royal New Zealand Fencible soldier who arrived in New Zealand on the ship Inchinnan. The ship left London on 14 January 1852, left Portland 28 January 1852 and arrived at Auckland New Zealand on 27 May 1852.

Gerard SAMPSON born 1819 enlisted and served 4 years 10 months with 2nd Reg. and 9 years 4 month with Coldstream Guards. He was discharged with palpitations. His height was 5 feet 8 inches, brown hair, grey eyes, fresh complexion, a very good character, occupation servant. He married Ellen MAHONEY (born 1825) and had 1 years old Mary who died on board ship. He paid his own passage to New Zealand. This family transferred to

Wellington. Gerard died in 1893 and his full name was Gerald DE THIERRY SAMPSON. His son Gerard was born 1853.
