My Dear Mother

We were very much pleased to get your letter and about a fortnight after that great paper. It was a great treat to have such a budget of news all at once. I think I have read every word of it. The news in it has given Carrie a much better opinion of New Zealand than she had before.

I am writing this from a dismal country place in the coldest winter we have had for 18 years. I was sent her by the firm I have been working for, for some time to take charge of a job building a new wing to a gentleman's house and alterations, but the weather is so bad that we can't get on but I hope it will soon break. We are eighty miles from Bristol so we can't get home very often. I have got Carrie and the children with me and I'm sure I don't know what I should do without them. The place is so dull for the river has overflowed its banks and there is nothing but ice for miles. I should not have come her but trade is so very bad that I was glad to accept a certain job for the winter. Trade was never known to be so bad before. There are thousands out of work in every large town and three large Banks have stopped payment. One of these, the West of England Bank in Cornwall. Which had quite spoiled trade in Bristol. The people I am working for are large losers and some of our oldest hands are walking about so I think I am very fortunate in having work. I hope I will always be as lucky as I have hitherto.

Dear Mother, about my coming out to you. I was rather disappointed at not having a letter from John but perhaps he will write next mail. I don't know whether they will start any free emigration next summer but if they do I'm afraid they won't take any farm labourers free and I am sure it will take years for me to save enough to bring us all out for things are so dear that there is not much to save out of our wages and I have had a death and a birth to provide for during the last year but still I have a little and I dare say when I have sold what I could not bring with me I should have about 20 pounds if nothing should occur to make it less. Second hand furniture does not fetch much now as poor people have no money to spare to buy it

but supposing I got that amount it would take the best part of it to pay railway fares and but clothes and other things that we could not do without. Do you think that John or the others would advance me the amount required? If so I am sure I could soon return it as I have always been able to get work her and always gave satisfaction to everyone I have worked for. But I must leave that to you, as I am a very poor beggar. I think that my Brothers do me this service, as it is the first favour I have ever asked of them. I was surprised to hear that you left enough money for me to come out although you spoke about when we parted in London. I always though it was only a small amount in case of illness.

Dear Mother whatever madder you send me the money for Father's watch, you may n=be sure I would not take it from you, but as I think of coming I hope to be able to return it to you with interest. I am very sorry to hear such a bad account of Tom, as it is the last thing I should have expected of him but we must hope he will soon alter. I should like to see him so much as I had more to do with him than with either of the others and I expect he would be glad to see me. Please send me an answer as soon as possible as I am very anxious to get it settled before next winter.

And now I must conclude with love to all and accept the same of yourself from your affectionate Son
George Foote.

PS Alice sends her love to her Grandmother and all her cousins over the water. She remembers you in her prayers every night.

George wrote this letter to his mother Avice who was living with her oldest son, John in Purakanui near Port Chalmers. It was written both horizontally and vertically, on both sides of the paper (quarto size)
