I Elizabeth RITSON of Wellington aforesaid Widow make oath and say as follows:

1. I am the widow of Thomas RITSON late of Wellington aforesaid Engineer who died at Wellington aforesaid & within the jurisdiction of this Honourable Court on the 24th day of August 1880.
2. I have made diligent search for the purpose of ascertaining whether the said Thomas RITSON left any Will at the time of his death but I have been unable to discover any such will a I verily believe that the said Thomas RITSON died without any Will
3. To the best of my knowledge information and belief the estate effects and credits of the deceased to be administered by me are under the value of One hundred pounds unless by the results of a Chavery suit now in proceeding in England I should as such administrator become entitled to any further sum.
4. Sworn by the said Elizabeth RITSON the same having been previously read over and explained to her by me and she appearing perfectly to understand the same ad having also previously made her mark there to in my presence this 28th day of March 1881. (Another document had 22 day of April 1881)

Informant Peter BRANIGAN son-in-law states that she was born Manchester England and died 12 January 1922 Wellington. Eliza Ann BRANIGAN also signed some of the official records.

This is the last will and testament of me Elizabeth RITSON of the city of Wellington on the colony of New Zealand livery stable keeper. I revoke all prior wills and I appoint the public trust of the colony of new Zealand to be executor and trustee of this my will. I bequeath my clothing jewellery and furniture and household and personal effects to my daughters to be divided amongst them as they shall agree and my piano to me daughter Isabella I direct my trustee in this discretion to permit my grandson Walter Alexander to carry on my business employing therein all my horses carriages and other stock in trade and having the use of the house stables and shop attached thereto paying him the sum of three pounds per week for wages ad the net income of the business after paying all rates taxes and assessments therein and all the charges shall be divided equally among my children Thomas, Eliza, and Isabella and my grandson Walter Alexander or to let the said stock in trade horses and carriages with the said house stables and shop and divide the net income equally among the said children Should my Trustee think it desirable to sell the said property with the stock in trade horses and carriages then I authorise him to do so and divided the proceeds equally among my said children I devise the house and land at Berhampore purchased from daughter Isabella HILL being Lots 8 and 9 part of Section 1063 to my said daughter Isabella for her life she paying all outgoings thereon and after her death for her children equally among them and if there shall be only one such child then Upon Trust for such child I Devise Lot7 part of Section 1063 Herald Street to my daughter Eliza Ann BRANIGAN for her life she paying all outgoings and after her death for her children equally among them and if there shall be only one such child then upon Trust for such child. I devise the house next to the stables in Cambridge Terrace to my son Thomas for his life he paying all outgoings and after

his death for my said two daughters Eliza and Isabella as tenants in common in equal shares. I devise my house next to last mentioned house to my son Walter for his life he paying all outgoings and after his death to my said two daughters Eliza and Isabella as tenants in common in equal shares. I devise my house in Lorne Street nearest to the stables being number 46 to my son Thomas for his life and after his death to my said two daughters Eliza and Isabella as tenants in common in equal shares The adjoining house being number 45 I devise to my daughter Eliza for her life she paying all outgoings and after her death to her children in equal shares and if there should be one such child then Upon Trust for such child. My other two houses in Lorne Street being number 44 and 44a I devise to my said Eliza for her life she paying all outgoings and after her death for her children in equal shares and if there shall be only one such child then Upon Trust for such child. I direct to be divided equally among my children I direct that in this will the word children or child if not inconsistent with the context including my grandson Walter Alexander.
