George Thomas HARRIS was born about 1825 Kilburn Middlesex London England. His father was James HARRIS occupation Licensed Victualler.

Baptisms solemnized in the Parish of Saint George Hanover Square in the County of Middlesex in the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Four (1824). George Thomas HARRIS was baptised 31 October 1824 son of Susanna and James HARRIS Kilbourn [sic] occupation servant minister J GLEN.

George Thomas HARRIS of full age, bachelor, occupation License Victualler married Ann CROSS of full age, spinster on 02 August 1849 at the Parish Church, St Marylebone, Middlesex, England. George's father was James HARRIS occupation Licensed Victualler. Ann's father was John CROSS occupation Licensed Victualler. Both couples signed the register. The witnesses were J H POUNCE and Elizabeth Hannah POUNCE. They were married by licence in the Parish Church by W H CHARLTON.

Ann HARRIS of full age widow from the parish of Islington in the County of Middlesex and William John WATSON of full age occupation builder in the District of All Saints St Marylebone married 29 April 1855 Langham Westminster. Ann's father was John CROSS licenced victualler (deceased) and William's father was William WATSON builder (deceased). The witnesses were James Henry Pounce and Elizabeth Hannah Pounce. The witness Elizabeth Hannah Pounce (nee Harris) was the sister of George Thomas Harris the deceased husband of Ann Watson ex Harris nee Cross.
