The Late Disastrous - Floods and Storms - GERALDINE - The fall of rain in this district on Monday was immense, more like the continuous pour from water spouts than the falling of ran. The damage in and near the township by the rising of the river is not so great as at the Temuka, but still it is considerable, as a great deal of property belonging to small holders has been damaged and destroyed. Large numbers of sheep principally belonging to Mr Cox, have been drowned, and all the crops more or less injured. A house belonging to a man named Donald Macdonald near the bush, with £40 or £50 therein, the hard earned savings of the owner was swept clean away. Captain Macpherson has lost a quantity of fencing, and McKenzie and Co. of the steam saw mills, had their stock-yard carried off, and about half-amile of a race used for the purpose of carrying water to the steam engine has not been seen since the flood. In the township, McIntyre, blacksmith, and Clouston, wheelwright, who lived in houses adjoining each other, had to leave their homes and seek shelter at Mr Cox's. Carts, standing in front of their shops floated away and have not been found again. The two houses were almost filled with a deposit of shingle, and a correspondent on Thursday rode over the top of a dray which had been completely buried in a like manner. Taylor, a carpenter, Kirby, and others had to leave their houses and seek refuge from the flood. The bridge near Francis has been destroyed. Kelman's house was washed away the inmates escaping with their lives. The river rose about seventeen feet during the flood.

Back to Island - German Escapees well equipped when found - Variety Of Goods - Back to Somes Island, scene of their escape just under a week ago, today went the three German internees who were yesterday captured by the police in scrub country off the Akatarawa road. It was discovered when they were caught that they had removed from the island an extraordinary quantity of material. Suitcases, blankets, suits of clothes, great-coats, a tent fly, a hot-water bag, and, most astounding of all, a portmanteau full of books, were in the possession of the three men, Hans Finke, Carl Oscar Schroeder, and Frederick Georg Theodor Strewe. It is understood, that the men were actually present at the 7 pm roll-call on

the night of their escape, and that by some means which has not yet been ascertained they scaled or otherwise negotiated the high barrier which surrounds the sleeping quarters. The police officers who made the arrest yesterday, Sergeant T Forsythe and Constable C E Tanner, of Upper Hutt, were in plain clothes, a fact which misled the escapees and resulted in a first show of resistance, one of the men being armed with a billet of wood. Once, however, the police produced automatic pistols the men put up their hands and were handcuffed. The purchase by Finke of tinned goods from an Upper Hutt store at 7.30 pm on Saturday led to the capture, the district where they were finally found being singled out for special attention. Yesterday morning Mr Arthur Clouston, manager of Odlin's Akatarawa mill, in company with Mr Eric Olivecrona, was driving along the Akatarawa road, nine miles from the Brown Owl in bad scrub country. They saw two heads in the scrub, and Mr Clouston stopped his truck and got out to stay at the spot while Mr Olivecrona drove on to Whiteman's farm to telephone the police. While he was absent Mr Clouston was joined by Mr Charles Muggeridge, who works on the road, and these men kept watch pending the arrival of the police. The men, when arrested, were in old clothes, unkempt, and showing signs of the hardship they had endured while eluding the authorities.

Smart Capture - Escaped Germans Surprised at Bivouac (P.A.) Wellington, this day. The recapture to-day of the three Germans who escaped from Somes Island, Hans Finke, Carl Oscar Schroeder and Frederick Georg Theodor Strewe, north of Upper Hutt near the Akatarawa Road, was made as a result of information supplied by people in the district. Sergeant F Forsythe and Constable C E Tanner, of Upper Hutt, in company with some employees of a sawmill, approached the three Germans, who were bivouacked away from the road, and arrested them without trouble. The fugitives were well equipped with clothing, blankets and stores and even a tent fly and hot water bottle. One had a large sum of money. They had been travelling on foot by night and hiding by day since their escape. One of the men was armed with a large piece of wood and was going to show fight until he saw that the police officers were armed. When they were caught they were in the middle of a hurried packing-up pending a further trek. Shortly after 11 am to-day Mr Arthur Clouston, manager of Odlin's Akatarawa mill, in company with Mr Eric Olivecrona, was driving along the Akatarawa road in bush country. They saw two heads behind some scrub. Mr Clouston stopped his truck and got out to stay at the spot while Mr Olivecrona drove on to Mr Whiteman's farm to telephone the Upper Hutt police. While Mr Olivecrona was absent Mr Clouston was joined by Mr Charles Muggeridge. Sergeant Forsythe and Constable Tanner arrived and found the fugitives. Finke rushed off down a gully on the approach of the police. The other two were handcuffed. Sergeant Forsythe went after Finke, who had taken to the scrub near the river. After being challenged twice the fugitive came out of hiding and surrendered. It is probable a Court of inquiry will be held concerning the circumstances of the escape. No charge can be brought against the escaped men under civil law for escaping.
