Elizabeth FRANCIS wife of Charles Francis of Petone Settler probate records record her will. Elizabeth bequeaths her estate to husband Charles Francis. In the event of Charles being deceased then £300 to May Olive Francis BENGGE wife of Joseph Samuel Bengge and some funds to “the Brethren”. She appointed Franklyn Ferguson of Palmerston North Editor of the Christian paper called “The Treasury” as Executor.
