George HART was born 1820 Westminster London England and baptised 10 February 1823 Saint Clement Danes Westminster Middlesex England. His parents were Marion nee Heggins and Robert Hart.

Sir

On the 29th of March 1853 I selected 150 acres of Land in the Upper Hutt having a frontage to the Hutt Road and adjoining Sections 171, 172. This land has not been surveyed by the Government and the tenant is now desirous of having his boundaries marked that he may fence I should be obliged if you could let me know when it will be surveyed

I remain Your Obedient Servant – George HART

The late Mr George Hart whose death occurred on Monday last was born in London in 1820. He came to the colony in 1843 in the ship Mary in company with his brother the late Hon. Robert Hart. They settled at Wellington and for many years took an active part in promoting the welfare of the colony. The late Mr George Hart took a trip to England and returned in 1850 to Canterbury but afterwards went back to Wellington where he became a member of the Provincial Council, and was in 1859 Speaker of that body. He again returned to Canterbury having taken up land at Winchmore and at the time of his death was the owner of that estate. He became a member of the Provincial Council of Canterbury and of the Land Board and other bodies and when the provinces were abolished he represented Coleridge for a time in the House of Representatives. For the last ten years the late Mr Hart had taken no active part in politics although he interested himself in many ways in matters pertaining to the welfare and progress of the colony. His wife and a grown up family survive him. For the last year he bore uncomplainingly a severe and at times painful illness. The funeral of the deceased gentleman took place to-day

George Hart - One of the earliest colonists, in the person of Mr George Hart who has been identified with New Zealand for more than fifty years and who until lately, was a well-known figure in Canterbury passed away on Monday. Mr Hart was born in London in 1820 and came out to the colony with his brother the late Hon Robert Hart in May 1843. The two brothers settled in Wellington and for some years both took an active part in the public life of the young colony. Both occupied many prominent positions and Mr George Hart was speaker of the Wellington Provincial Council for some time. About the year 1849 he visited England but returned to the colony the next year in the Phoebe Dunbar arriving in Lyttelton a few weeks before the historical first four ships and formed one of the committee to welcome the Canterbury Pilgrims. He decided to settle in this province, and took up the Winchmore Estate in the Ashburton district, as well as several other properties. He sat in the Provincial Council for many years up to the time of the abolition of the Provinces and was a prominent member of the Land Board. In 1876 he represented Ashburton in the House of Representatives. For the last ten years he had retired from active political work but continued to take a keen interest in all matters that affected the welfare of the colony. During the past year he had been afflicted with a protracted and at times painful illness which he bore with the utmost patience. He was a man of kindly disposition and did a good deal in an unobtrusive way, for charity. In 1859 he married Miss Kenison-James of Sydney and leaves a widow and grown-up family to mourn their loss. The funeral will leave the late residence of deceased at 2 pm to-day for the Linwood Public Cemetery.
