Sister Agatha of the Otaki Convent is a daughter. The funeral took place today while requiem mass was celebrated at Buckle Street Church.

Sisters of the Past – Sister Agatha Catherine Hurley 17 February 1875 – 26 May 1952

Wellington New Zealand was the birthplace of Catherine daughter of Jeremiah Hurley and his wife Annie nee O'Sullivan on 17 February 1875. Jeremiah has been a teacher at Tralee Poor Law Union School in Ireland and had married Annie also a school teacher at the Catholic Chapel of Tralee on 05 November 1870. Their first son Daniel was born before they set sail for NZ in June 1872. After arrival Jeremiah became a teacher at Kaiwharawhara and in 1879 moved to a new school at Trentham [Upper Hutt]. Catherine was born in 1875 and her sister Annie in 1877.

Their older brother Daniel died soon after arrival in NZ and their mother Annie also died while they were still young. They were cared for by Daniel and Bridget Hurley, brother and sister in law of Jeremiah until he was remarried to Eva Lynch in 1880. His son from the second marriage he also named Daniel and he had five more daughters. Young Daniel was born in 1883 and later became Father Dan Hurley SM and Provincial of Marist Order in Australasia. In his later years Jeremiah Hurley gave the land at Kuku near Otaki for the building of a church. Catherine and Annie were boarders at Sacred Heart in Whanganui. When she left school Catherine entered the Sisters of St Joseph on 25 April 1899, three years after her sister Annie, who became Sister Augustine. She was professed on 04 February 1901, the name of Sister Agatha. Agatha was a primary school teacher and house sister and was a foundation member when the School and Convent were opened at Waipukurau in 1926. She also taught at Waverley, Mangaweka and Patea. Agatha was remembered as a very gentle women who was very placid and accepting of life's difficulties. Sister Agatha died in Whanganui on 26 May 1952. Her funeral was held at Sacred Heart Convent and she was buried at Aramoho Lawn cemetery

Sister Augustine Annie Hurley 09 September 1877 – 05 November 1972

In November 1870 Jeremiah Hurley married Annie O'Sullivan at the Catholic Chapel of Tralee County Kerry Ireland. Both were school teachers. Jeremiah taught at the Tralee Poor Law Union School in Tralee. A son Daniel Joseph was born to them in 1871 and then in June 1872 with the help of a Government subsidy they set sail for New Zealand. Soon after arrival Jeremiah began teaching in Kaiwharawhara, Upper Hutt and Trentham. Anne was born on 09 September 1877 and later another daughter Kathleen but the son had died soon after their arrival. Annie's mother died while the children were young and they were taken in by Jeremiah's brother Daniel and his wife Bridget. Her father married Eva Lynch in 1880. She gave birth to a son also named Daniel and five daughters. The family moved to a farm at Kuku near Ohau. When the Marist Fathers needed land for a church a corner of the farm was given and the family worshipped at St Stephen's Church built there. Annie and her sister Kathleen were sent to board at Sacred Heart Convent in Whanganui and on completing her schooling Annie entered the Sisters of St Joseph on 07 March 1896. She was professed as Sister Augustine on 21 January 1898. Sister Augustine became a very gifted teacher, and used her talents in music and the arts to instruct many hundreds of children. During her 76 years as a Sister of St Joseph Augustine held many positions of responsibility including that of Mistress of Novices. She was the Foundation Superior of Fielding (1906) Taihape (1916) Convents and a founding member of the Mangaweka (1922 Convent also. She spent an initial ten years as head teacher in Feilding and then returned as principal for six years in 1938. She also taught at Waverley, Hastings, Waipukurau, Plimmerton and Otaki. Her last appointment was to Otaki where she endeared herself to the Maori people. Kathleen Augustine sister also entered the Sisters and was professed as Sister Agatha in 1901 and died in 1952. Her brother Daniel became a Marist Priest. Augustine died in Otaki on 05 November 1972. The respect and loyalty of her many former pupils was much in evidence at her funeral Mass held in the local parish church. As a mark of the esteem in which they held Sister Augustine and her family the Maori people placed a mat over her coffin and sang several of the hymns during the Mass. The casket was carried up the Pukekaraka Hill nearby where Sister was buried near some of the pioneer Sisters and clergy

Agatha was a primary school teacher and house sister and was a foundation member when the School and Convent were opened at Waipukurau in 1926. She also taught at Waverley, Mangaweka and Patea. Agatha was remembered as a very gentle women who was very placid and accepting of life's difficulties Sister Agatha died in Whanganui on 26 May 1952. She gave birth to a son also named Daniel and five daughters. The family moved to a farm at Kuku near Ohau. When the Marist Fathers needed land for a church a corner of the farm was given and the family worshipped at St Stephen's Church built there. Annie and her sister Kathleen were sent to board at Sacred Heart Convent in Whanganui and on completing her schooling Annie entered the Sisters of St Joseph on 07 March 1896. She was professed as Sister Augustine on 21 January 1898. Sister Augustine became a very gifted teacher, and used her talents in music and the arts to instruct many hundreds of children. During her 76 years as a Sister of St Joseph Augustine held many positions of responsibility including that of Mistress of Novices. She was the Foundation Superior of Fielding (1906) Taihape (1916) Convents and a founding member of the Mangaweka (1922) Convent also. She spent an initial ten years as head teacher in Feilding and then returned as principal for six years in 1938. She also taught at Waverley, Hastings, Waipukurau, Plimmerton and Otaki. Her last appointment was to Otaki where she endeared herself to the Maori people. Kathleen Augustine sister also entered the Sisters and was professed as Sister Agatha in 1901 and died in 1952. Her brother Daniel became a Marist Priest. Augustine died in Otaki on 05 November 1972. The respect and loyalty of her many former pupils was much in evidence at her funeral Mass held in the local parish church. As a mark of the esteem in which they held Sister Augustine and her family the Maori people placed a mat over her coffin and sang several of the hymns during the Mass. The casket was carried up the Pukekaraka Hill nearby where Sister was buried near some of the pioneer Sisters and clergy reference Sisters of St Joseph Whanganui website
