Information recorded that around 1887 Moses WALSH left New Zealand for Sydney Australia due to his state of health. Later he went on to Brisbane in Queensland Australia. His wife Ann WALSH was left to bring up their 7 children on her own in Wellington.

Moses WALSH died 27 August 1889 in Clermont Hospital Queensland Australia. Moses father was Thomas Walsh

Ann Walsh sworn
I reside at No 11 Tonks Grove Wellington. I am the wife of Moses Walsh. I was married at St Patrick's Cathedral Melbourne in 1871. I came to New Zealand about 33 years ago, and landed at Wellington. I came by the steamer Arawata, my husband came to New Zealand 3 years before I did. I produce a letter which I received from the War Office sometime in October this year. My husband was discharged from the Regiment at Melbourne Victoria on the 26th January 1870. His character was "Good" I lost his discharge about 18 months ago in Tennyson Street Wellington. I don't think my husband ever got any scrip or land for his services during the Maori War. I produce his New Zealand War Medal which is inscribed "89 Corpl Walsh 2nd Bn. 187th Foot." I have heard my husband speak of engagements the Regiment took part in at Patea, Auckland and Wanganui. My husband left me about 23½ years ago. He went to Sydney. I afterwards learnt from the place where he stayed that he went on Brisbane in Queensland. That was the last I have heard from him. I don't know whether my husband is dead or alive. When he left me he was in a very delicate sate of health, and that was the reason he went to Sydney. I have had to bring up 7 children. I wrote to the Inspector of Police at Brisbane to see if he could be trace my husband's whereabouts. The Police replied to my letter saying that they could not trace him. I also caused inquiries to be made at the Office of Births & Deaths at Brisbane but without results. I have never made an application for a grant to previous Commissions. When my husband got his medal he gave to me saying "this is all I have got for my labour." I was informed by Colonel Robin about 4 weeks ago that my husband made an application for a grant of land I think in 1886 but as far as I know he never got it.

I have assumed that Moses Walsh is dead. Mr Walsh's service has been established by the letter of the 02nd August 1910 from the War Office to Mrs Ann Walsh and by production of New Zealand War Medal.

Referring to the application of Mrs M Walsh for compensation on account of her husband's Military service, together with minute of evidence taken by you and your recommendation. I have to inform you that it is observed that according to the statement of Mr Walsh her husband did not return to New Zealand after being discharged in 1870 at Melbourne until 1874. This claim therefore does not come within Section 2 clause (a) of the Naval and Military Settlers and Volunteers Land Act 1892 which limits the time for settling in New Zealand – "at any time before the 31st December 1872".

In view of this do you wish to alter or amend the recommendation you have in favour of Mr Walsh.
