Robert Sefton Adams born 07 Aug 1888 London England, left England, arrived NZ with parents Jessie & Dr Harry Adams, educated Terrace School, 1907 head prefect Wellington Boys College, left NZ for UK, studied Law at Cambridge, married 14 Nov 1913 London England Mary Stanley Carpenter, 2 daughters Yvonne born 1914 & Margaret born 1915, Captain Royal Field Artillery 35<sup>th</sup> Brigade 12 Battery enlisted Aug 1916, killed 05 Oct 1917 France, buried Zantvoorde British Cemetery Belgium West-Vlaanderen, parents residence "Rangimarie" Silverstream Wellington New Zealand.  
UH connection – Robert's parents resided in Silverstream Upper Hutt during the war and after. Robert's wooden grave marker cross which was replaced with an inscribed headstone came into the possession of his mother Jessie. She placed the cross on the back wall of St Mary's Church in Silverstream.

Ralph Hilton ASHFORD born 1897 England, Corporal 4197 13<sup>th</sup> Royal Sussex Regiment received Victory Medal, married 1921 Croydon Surrey England Edith Ada Woodward, 1922 departed England, settled NZ, resided Upper Hutt, died 24 Jul 1962 Upper Hutt, buried Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt  
UH connection – Ralph resided Upper Hutt, died and buried Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt

BALCOMBE-BROWN Rainsford 1895-1918                      Major NN                      British  
Rainsford Balcombe Brown born 1895 NZ, parents Eliza Mary nee Baillie & Edward Balcombe Brown, educated NZ, 1912 departed NZ, settled England and attended Oxford, enlisted WWI 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant Royal Flying Corps, recorded in the local Upper Hutt newspaper as one of "Our Boys", parents resided Cruickshank Road Upper Hutt, promoted to Captain, awarded Military Cross July 1916, Mentioned in Dispatches, 1917 Squadron Leader with rank Major, reported missing, killed in action 02 May 1918, buried France, 1922 military cross presented to widowed mother at Government house Wellington, recorded on memorial plaque at Old St Pauls Church Wellington.  
UH connection – Rainsford's parents resided in Upper Hutt, local "Hutt Valley Independent" newspaper recorded him as one of "Our Boys".

BALCOMBE-BROWN William Edward 1893-1915                      Lieutenant NN                      British  
William Edward Balcombe Brown born 1893 NZ, parents Eliza Mary nee Baillie & Edward Balcombe Brown, educated NZ, 1912 departed NZ, settled England and attended Oxford, enlisted WWI Lieutenant Royal Field Artillery 68<sup>th</sup> Battery, recorded in the local Upper Hutt newspaper as one of "Our Boys", parents resided Cruickshank Road Upper Hutt, killed in action by shell in France 29 June 1915, buried Buffs Road cemetery Leper West-Vlaanderen Belgium, name recorded on memorial plaque at Old St Pauls Church Wellington.  
UH connection – William's parents resided in Upper Hutt, local "Hutt Valley Independent" newspaper recorded him as one of "Our Boys".

BALNEAVES Alexander 1890-1972                      Private 247                      British  
Alexander Balneaves born 11 Sep 1890 Scotland, Private 247 1<sup>st</sup> Gordon Highlanders prisoner of War awarded Victory Medal & British War Medal & 1914 Star date 13 August 1914, departed England, settled NZ, resided Petone, died 03 Apr 1972, buried Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt  
UH connection – Alexander died and buried Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt

BARTON Wilfred Tone 1892-1969                      Lieutenant                      British  
Wilfred Tone Barton born 1892, parents Isabella & John, Sheep farmer Trentham, Flight Sub Lieutenant Royal Flying Corp, invalided home, died 1969 New Zealand. The local newspaper recorded "*Our Boys Wilfred Barton son of John Barton of Trentham who went home at his own expense to join the Flying Corps is being invalided home owing to having developed bronchial*

*asthma. Out of 200 applications only ten passed the test examinations and of these Wilfred topped the lists. His flying secured him a sub-lieutenancy and he looked forward to some active service but his breathing became affected and he was thereby robbed of his chance. Hard Luck. Isn't it. Tried to do his bit and has not cost the country a copper*

ÜH connection – Wilfred worked and resided in Trentham and was mentioned in the local newspaper

BOOTH Clarence Thomas 1892-1958 Private 137562 British

Clarence Thomas Booth born 1892 Shardlow Derbyshire England, parents Elizabeth and Thomas Booth, Private 137562 Royal Army Service Corps medal roll stamped Woolwich 30 July 1920, departed England, settled NZ, resided Silverstream then Whitemans Valley, died 21 Aug 1958, buried Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt

UH connection – Clarence resided Upper Hutt died and buried Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt

BROWN Harold Farman 1890-1955 Company Sergeant Major 62842 British

Harold Farman Brown born 1890 Aldeby Norfolk England, he was bought up by his grandparents Lucy Ann & George Farman, Company Sergeant Major 62842 2<sup>nd</sup> G.B. Northumberland Fusiliers, 9<sup>th</sup> Battalion Northumberland Fusiliers Corporal 14906 & 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Northumberland Fusiliers 14906, awarded 1914-15 Star (14906 30 August 1915), departed England, settled NZ, resided Upper Hutt, died 14 Nov 1955 buried Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt

CAVELL Edith 1865-1915 Nurse NN British

Edith Louisa Cavell born 04 Dec 1865 Norfolk England, parents Louisa Sophia & Rev Frederick Cavell, WWI British nurse who saved the lives of soldiers on both side without discrimination, helped some 200 Allied soldiers to escape from German occupied Belgium, arrest for treason found guilty and executed by a German firing squad on 2 Oct 1915 Brussels Belgium. The local "Hutt Valley Independent" newspaper reported on a memorial service held in Upper Hutt in Memoriam to the memory of "Nurse Cavell of the NZ Marquette Nurses. She was not a New Zealand nurse that drowned on the Marquette but was executed by the Germans.

UH connection – Edith had no connection but was mentioned in the local Upper Hutt newspaper.

Daniel McGregor Clark born 13 Mar 1893, Private 4/2214 served British Imperial Force, departed England, settled NZ, resident Silverstream, died 01 Jun 1974, buried Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt

CURRIE Alexander 1897-1972 Private 23616 British

Alexander Currie born 24 May 1897 Scotland, Private 23616 the Gordon Highlanders 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> awarded Victory Medal & British War Medal place Perth date 30 July 1920, departed England, settled NZ, returned England 1958, returned NZ, resided Upper Hutt, died 24 Mar 1972, buried Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt

UH connection – Alexander resided Upper Hutt, died and buried Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt

CUTTS George 1873-1952 Private 402790 British

George Cutts born 1873 Hertfordshire England, parents Eliza & John Cutts, married 28 Jul 1906 Surrey England Frances Kathleen Hubbard, son Stanley born 1908 Surrey England, Private 402790 Royal Army Service Corps Church Army awarded British War Medal served France entry date July 1917, departed England, settled NZ, resided Palfrey Street Wallaceville, died 15 Jan 1952 Upper Hutt, buried St Johns Churchyard Trentham Upper Hutt.

DENNISON Dudley Timothy 1893-1970 Lieutenant 50106 British

Road Tooting, attested 17 February 1915 London, France 05 March 1915, home 06 February 1919, discharge 04 March 1919, age 24, Motor Driver, height 5ft 9inches, awarded 1914-15 Star, British War Medal & Victory Medal, departed England, settled NZ, WW2 Lieutenant Somes Battalion NZ, resided Silverstream Hospital, died 12 Nov 1970 buried Akatarawa cemetery

Arthur Leonard DE MENNA born 1890 Huddersfield England, parents Mary Jane & Michael David Dante Allin Dimenna, Driver/Gunner L29421 Royal Field Artillery Hudd Brigade address 78 Longwood Road Huddersfield occupation Cloth designer, married 02 June 1915 Florence Mary Dutton Longwood, joined 08 June 1915, discharged 08 March 1919, age 25 years 110 days, height 5ft 6½inches, departed England, settled NZ, resided Chatsworth Road Silverstream, died 07 Jul 1965, buried Akatarawa cemetery Upper Hutt.
