

Upper Hutt Public School - Roll of Honour

The Upper Hutt School has a World War One memorial board that lists the names of 88 former students who served in World War One. Those killed in action number 17 and those wounded number 23. This memorial board was stored in a cupboard behind the stage in the schools hall. After a the School jubilee in 2014 the committee organised for the board to be repaired so I am not sure where it is now.
