During World War One around **236** service personnel associated with the Eastern Bays district enlisted for service and/or registered with the First or Second Reserves. The list is made up of **10** (typed in red) who died while serving, **82** who were discharged after service, **1** (typed in blue) defaulter, **2** (typed in blue) Nurses, **2** (typed in blue) who served with British Force, **33** who registered with the First Reserves and **106** with the Second Reserves.
