Belmont – Maungaraki - Normandale

During World War One around **72** service personnel associated with the Western Hills district enlisted for service and/or registered with the First or Second Reserves. The list is made up of **5** (typed in red) who died while serving, **13** who were discharged after service, **1** (typed in blue) defaulter, **13** who registered with the First Reserves and **40** with the Second Reserves.
