William LECKIE was born about 1816 in Scotland.

William LECKIE married about 1839 place unknown Mary CRAWFORD.

William LECKIE and his wife Mary arrived in Wellington New Zealand on 20 February 1840 aboard the "*Bengal Merchant*".
(Reference "*Founders of the British Colony of New Zealand January 1840 to December 1845*)

The "*Bengal Merchant*" left the port of Glasgow Scotland on 30 October 1839 and arrived in Port Nicholson on 20 February 1840. The passenger list recorded:

- Wm. LECKIE Farm servant aged 23
- Wife LECKIE age 24

Also on board the Bengal Merchant was an Isaba [sic] LECKIE occupation servant. She may have been related to William.

Also on board the Bengal Merchant was George CRAWFORD age 27 and James CRAWFORD. They may have been related to Mary LECKIE formerly CRAWFORD.

Before emigrating to New Zealand William LECKIE had been engaged by Mr W R (Robt. Rog.) STRANG. Mr STRANG and his wife (R.S.) were cabin passengers aboard the Bengal Merchant.

William and Mary LECKIE would have been one of the early settlers to make a home in the first settlement called Britannia which was up river from the Petone foreshore on the banks of the Heretaunga (Hutt) River in the Hutt Valley.

Wm (William) LECKIE was one of Wellington's early settlers who first settled in Petone.

William and Mary had a daughter Mary LECKIE who was born on 20 May 1841 at Petone New Zealand and was baptised 28 June 1841.

William LECKIE died before 09 June 1856 in the Hutt district Wellington New Zealand. His daughter Mary would have been 15 years old at the time. I have searched and have been unable to locate a death registration for William

Nelson Examiner & New Zealand Chronicle 28 June 1856

28th June 1856 – New Zealand Provinces – Wellington

An inquest was held at the Hutt, on the 9th June, on the body of a man named William Leckie, who, in a fit of delirium tremens, left his bed on a freezing cold night, without clothing, and appears to have wandered about until he fell down and died from exhaustion and exposure to the cold.

1856 Inquest held in the House of Matthew COOK in Hutt district (Lower Hutt). Giving evidence were Matt COOK and Archibald PHILLIPS. Present on 09 June 1856 were the Coroner and Jury. They concluded that William LECKIE died from exposure to cold he not being at the house in a sound state of mind.
