The family history of Edward Lewis BATT and Alice Edith MANSSSEN

Alice Edith MANSSSEN was born on 23 May 1875 Stoke Nelson NZ. She was the youngest of the twins born to Charles Frederick MANSSSEN occupation Labourer and Emma Elizabeth MANSSSEN formerly MARRIS. C F MANSSSEN the father a labourer of Stoke registered the birth on 29 June 1875. The registrar was Rob RICKETT Nelson New Zealand. Alice's twin was recorded as Carl William MANSSSEN but her birth registration recorded that she was a boy and we all know that Alice was definitely a girl.

Alice Edith MANSSSEN younger of the twins was born 23 May 1875 Stoke Nelson NZ. Her parents were Emma Elizabeth former MARRIS and Charles Frederick MANSSSEN occupation labourer. C F MANSSSEN the father occupation labourer of Stokes registered the birth on 29 June 1875. The registrar was Robert PICKETT. Her twin brother was Carl William MANSSSEN.

Alice was believed to have been educated at Stoke School and may have spent some time before that at the Hampden Street School.

Edward Lewis BATT was born 23 February 1876 Waimea South. His parents were Harry BATT age 27 years born Richmond Nelson occupation Labourer and Mary BATT formerly NEWBERRY age 24 born England.

Edward's father Henry was born in Richmond. Henry's parents John and Ann BATT arrived in Nelson on the ship Olympus in 1842.

Edward's mother Mary was born in England. I have not researched any of Mary's details but I believe she came to Nelson about 1863 with her parents.

Alice Edith MANSEN age 28 years spinster married Edward Lewis BATT age 27 years bachelor occupation Saw Miller on the 31 August 1903 in the Wesleyan Church Masterton by minister Daniel J MURRAY. Alice was born Stoke Nelson and her dwelling place was Masterton. Her parents were Charles Frederick Henry MANSSSEN occupation Labourer and Emma Elizabeth MANSSSEN formerly MARRIS. Edward was born Wai-iti Nelson and his dwelling place was Masterton. His parents were Henry BATT occupation Orchardist and Mary Ann BATT formerly NEWBERRY. The witnesses were Henry Benjamin STIMPOOR Labourer of Masterton and Mary Ethel MANSSSEN (Alice's younger sister) Nelson.

A descendant told me that the family did not approve of the marriage but considering that Alice's younger sister was a witness the marriage show that this tale might not be correct. Alice had only been in Masterton for five days before the wedding took place and Edward had been there for 8 months. It is my belief that they met in their hometown of Nelson where they were both born and raised.

East Road Shannon was the last home that Alice and Edward would share together.

Alice Edith BATT formerly MANSSEN died on 19 October 1938 at Palmerston North Hospital from Shannon. She was age 63 years born Stokes occupation married women. Cause of death was Pnumoccal meningitis 3 days, Otitis media and Mastoiditis 2 weeks as certified by Dr R W Medbcott who saw her last on 18 October 1938. Alice's parents were Emma Elizabeth formerly MARRIS and Charles Frederick Henry MANSSEN occupation Labourer. She was buried on 21 October 1938 at Shannon cemetery by Church of England minister Rev E W BURGIN. Alice was age 28 when she married Edward Lewis BATT in Masterton. Her living issues were 6 males age 34, 33, 31, 29, 21 & 20 years and 1 female age 24 years. The undertaker G W BINGGS of Palmerston North registered the death on 21 October 1938. The deputy registrar was J D KERR.

Horowhenua District Council Shannon cemetery Register No 189 records that Alice Edith BATT died 19 October 1938 age 63 years, cause of death heart failure and date of burial 21 October 1938 in plot 49 block XVI. Service carried out by Reverend BURGIN of the Anglican Church. The Funeral Directors were Thomas GRIGG & sons Palmerston North. To locate the Alice's unmarked grave begin at the gateway walk straight ahead counting 6 rows then turn right (block XVI Taylor graves on both left and right sides) count 14 graves on your right and you will be standing in front of Alice's plot 49. On her left WARMAN (48) and right HENSMAN (50).

I was told that after Alice's death there was a fire in the family home at Shannon. Edward liked collecting papers and used to store them in the bedroom. While he was shopping in Shannon the neighbour lit a fire in his backyard. A spark drifted through the open window onto the stack of papers and a major fire began. Many family photos were lost forever.

Edward moved from East Road Shannon to Cook Street Foxton. This may have been after the fire.

Edward Lewis BATT age 73 years occupation labourer died on 12 May 1949 at Cook Street Foxton. Cause of death was Cardiac Failure sudden –Myocardial degeneration several years as certified by DR S E CRAWFORD who saw him last on 02 May 1949. There were no details recorded about his parents. Edward was buried on 13 May 1949 at Foxton Cemetery. He was born in Nelson and was age 27 when he married Alice Edith MANSSESN [sic] in Masterton. His living issue were recorded as 6 males age 45, 44, 42, 40, 32 and 31 years old and 1 female age 35 years old.
