ALLEGED STEALING

Dinah Koch was prosecuted on the charge of stealing a fowl valued at 5s the property of John Henry Turner, Martin-square and pleaded Not Guilty. The prisoner was defended by Mr Skerrett. On Friday last the prosecutor fed his birds before

going to work and on returning at night he missed one of the fowls. Although the case was a most trumpery one it occupied the attention of the bench for upwards an hour. The Bench considered the case proved, but as the accused had been already sufficiently punished she would be discharged.
