The eight known deserters were Thomas Anderson, William Bourke, William Cochrane, James Dunn, William Hartland, William Humphries, Moses McDonald, John Murray and possible George Vart.

George VART (DAVIDSON) - Served 3 December 1865 - disbandment, 30 October 1867. Private. Possibly deserted. Occupation: seaman. Born 1843, Whitby, Yorkshire, England.

Vart's medal application (dated 10 October 1913) states Address: C/- John Bland. 133 Grey Street, Auckland. Corps: Forest Rangers raised by Major von Tempsky at Wanaque in December 1865. Private served for 6 or 7 months. Forest Rangers in the expeditionary force under General Chute. Field service: Capture of pas by General Chute's force at Okotuku [4 January 1866], Te Putahi [7 January 1866], Otapawa [14 January 1866], Warea and Waikoko [1 February 1866] in Taranaki taking part in capture with the Forest Rangers in the early part of 1866. "The application is signed "George Vart". In the letter accompanying his application, Vart states, "I was under the name of Davidson in the Forest Rangers...A man by name of Alexander Davidson [friend] was wounded [Waikoko, 1 February 1866]...and I was sent back to Taranaki Hospital as an escort. As soon as he recovered from his wound I was sent to Wanganui to re-

join the Company. It wasn't there at time. I took part in no further engagements and left the Company soon after. There was no number of the Company to my knowledge. Just Forest Rangers. Under Major von Tempsky. There were 45 to 50 in the Company. All the men in charge of Major von Tempsky. Sergeant Birchfield and Sergeant {Lawrence} Burns....We were acting as an advance to General Chute's army. I was enrolled at Aramoho, Wanganui. I was a sailor and got discharged from ship. Met Alexander Davidson and we decided to join von Tempsky, which we did. I enlisted under the name of Davidson." John Gillanders made a statement substantiating Vart's application. He says "In view, however, of his admission that he joined under the name of Davidson in order that he might the more easier clear out if he got tired of the service and of the fact that he left the Company before disbandment and went inland to work on a farm under his own name [Vart]." A comment written on his application says "Unable to recommend his application until he proves that he got discharge. There seems to be a considerable probability that he deserted." There is no proof on the file that a medal was issued. Medal claim AD32/634
