The witnesses at the marriage were Jas Chas CURTIS who made his X mark and Leah CURTIS. Both bride and groom signed the register. The rector was F J WALKER M.A.

the death Union Street Faringdon. The cause of death was IA Carcinoma of Stomach no P.M. as certified by Graham SKINBORNE (sic) M.D.
