### The family history of Thomas YATES and Florence RYMAN

Thomas YATES was born on the 6 December 1875 Street Lane Radcliffe Bury, Elton in the County of Lancaster England. His parents were recorded as Ann formerly SCHOLES and Thomas YATES occupation Coal-Miner. The birth was registered by the mark X of Ann YATES mother of Street Lane Radcliffe on 11 January 1876. The registrar was John SMETHURST.

Florence RYMAN was born on the 16 October 1883 at Bromsgrove Place Faringdon R.S.D. in the Counties of Berkshire, Oxford and Gloucestershire England. Her parents were Alice formerly CURTIS and George Edward RYMAN occupation Haulier. The birth was registered by, George E RYMAN father of Bromsgrove Place Faringdon on 3 November 1883. The registrar was William NOAD.

Thomas YATES aged 29 years bachelor occupation Stable man and Florence RYMAN aged 20 years spinster married on the 18 June 1904 at the Register Office in the district of Faringdon in the County of Berkshire, Oxford and Gloucester England. Thomas's residence at the time of marriage was Kingstone Warred (sic) Kingstone district Berkshire and Florence "The Bakers Arms" Uffington. The fathers were recorded as Thomas YATES (deceased) a Green Grocer and George Edward RYMAN an Innkeeper. The witnesses were Elsie RYMAN (the bride's sister) and John MONEY. The marriage was signed by the registrar Henry WILLIAMS and Alan G HAINES Superintendent Registrar.

Thomas YATES served in World War Two. His service number was 18196 of the AVCSE (Army Veteran Corps) and his religion was listed as Church of England. He was awarded two medals. His medals the 1914-18 Star is held by his grandson YATES in New Zealand. We do not know who has the other medal, which I believe could be the British War Medal 1914-18.

In 1922 Thomas and Florence made the decision to immigrate to New Zealand and join some of Thomas's siblings. Florence also had some distant New Zealand relatives from a common RYMAN ancestor (chart 80-81) who arrived in New Zealand around 1875.

The Wellington Maritime Museum records state that the "Pakeha" left Liverpool via Panorama on 19 January 1922 and arrive in Wellington New Zealand on 27 February 1922.

The ship "Pakeha" left the port of South Hampton Liverpool England on 19 January 1922 and arrived at Port Nicholson Wellington New Zealand on the 20/30 February 1922. The "Pakeha" was a Shaw Savill & Albion Company Ltd ship. The Master/Captain signed the report on 1<sup>st</sup> March 1922. The passenger list read:

Upon arriving in Wellington Thomas & Florence and their family went to live on a Stud farm in Waikanae where Thomas worked for Mr Duncan who owned thoroughbred stud horses. Thomas assisted in the training of the horses.

Thomas and his family later left Waikanae and moved to Korokoro on the hills above Petone where he then worked at the Wool Stores in Petone.

When the children attended Korokoro School their parent Thomas's address was recorded as Waikanae, which makes me think that perhaps the family was living in Korokoro while their father Thomas was living in Waikanae.

One of their sons told me that the family moved to Petone for a while and later returned to Korokoro.

The family left Korokoro and moved to Islington Street Trentham Upper Hutt near the Trentham Race Course. It was here that Thomas had his own stables (son called it "Trained Public") and trained horses and had his own racing colours. These racing colours are held by one of his YATES grandchildren in Auckland New Zealand.

Thomas YATES age 66 years born Radcliffe Lancashire England occupation Horse Trainer died on the 21 September 1943 at Wellington Hospital from Islington Street Trentham. Cause of death was recorded as Toxaemia-months Bed Sores-Months Haeato myclia-11 months as certified by medical attendant Dr E GIBBONS who saw Thomas last on 20<sup>th</sup> September. Thomas was buried on 23 September 1943 at St John's Churchyard Trentham. The Anglican minister W.E.D. DAVIES took the service.

His parents were recorded as Ann formerly SCHOLES and Thomas YATES occupation Coal Miner. Thomas had dwelled in New Zealand for 21 years (arrived about 1912) and was age 21 when he married Florence RYMAN in Berkshire England now widow age 59 years. His living issue were recorded as 3 males aged 29, 34 & 32 years and 3 females aged 31, 29 and 22 years. The death was registered by Undertaker W A Wilson of Wellington on 29<sup>th</sup> September 1943. The registrar was H BOWKES.

Florence YATES aged 79 years born Faringdon, Hampshire England occupation widow died on 17 April 1963 at 48 Vauxhall Road Devonport Auckland. Cause of death was Hemiplegia 2-3 hours and Arteriosclerosis-years as certified by Medical Attendant Dr E C GRANT who last saw her last on 17<sup>th</sup> April. Florence was buried on the 20 April 1963 at the St John's Churchyard Trentham next to her husband Thomas. Her parent's were Alice formerly CURTIS and George Edward RYMAN and she had dwelled in New Zealand for 41 years (arrive about 1912). Florence married age 20 years to Thomas YATES in Faringdon, Hampshire England. Her living issue were recorded as 3 males aged 59, 53 and 49 years and 2 females aged 56 and 51 years. The death was registered on 22 April 1963 by the Funeral Director C L Montiquanr of Upper Hutt. The registrar was T.A.F. Withers.

Frederick told his brother that Uffington was about 8-10 miles from Faringdon. He visited the house he was born which is now a private residence named "Bakers Arms" which was originally the name of the pub owned by his RYMAN grandparents.

Frederick was aged 18 years old when he arrived in New Zealand in 1922.

In World War Two Frederick YATES service number 72293 (also noted 378094) was recorded as a conscientious objector. His Army records state that his occupation was Bricklayer at the School of Instruction Trentham. He was born 9-9-1904 England, aged 36 years, 5 feet 5¾ inches in height, Brown hair, Grey eyes, Medium complexion and

single. One record stated that he was marched out to defaulters detention camp on the 7<sup>th</sup> January 1942. His parents were recorded as Florence formerly RYMAN and Thomas YATES. His religion was Undernominal and his next of kin was father Mr T Yates, Islington Street Trentham. His educational qualifications were recorded as 6<sup>th</sup> Standard English. The attestation form was signed on 5<sup>th</sup> December 1940 in Wellington. Another recorded stated that he was marched out to Defaulters detection Camp on 8<sup>th</sup> January 1944/42 [sic].

He entered camp on 5-7-1941 and Embarked for overseas duty in Egypt, Middle East, Italy Alexandria on 13-9-1941 and returned to NZ on 6-9-1945 and was discharged 14-12-1945. He was Mention in Dispatches and his medal entitlement was 1939-45 Star, Africa Star, 8<sup>th</sup> Army Clasp, Italy Star, Defence Medal, War Medal 1939-45 and NZ War Service Medal. Corporal Robert YATES served for a total of 4 years 163 days.

On enlistment he was recorded as born 6-10-1910 England aged 29 years, 5 feet 8 inches (after discharge 5 feet 9 inches), Brown hair, Brown eyes, Medium complexion, single, religion Church of England, occupation Deputy Foreman Motor Body Builder for



NZ Motor Building Builders Petone and next of kin mother Florence Yates, Islington Street Trentham. He served with the NZ Territorial Forces 17<sup>th</sup> Battery from 1927 until 18-3-1929. Educational qualifications were recorded as Standard IV Competency. His parents were Florence formerly RYMAN and Thomas YATES both born in England. Noted on his registration was "Knowledge of Race horses, Father a trainer". His "Mention in Despatches" was published in the London Gazette 23 May 1946. Robert received on 29 March 1949 a message from the Authorities in England signed by the Secretary of State for War in high appreciation of His Majesty the King in connection with having been Mentioned in Despatches for distinguished service. Robert was wounded twice (5-12-1943 & 15-2-1944) after receiving Gunshot in the right arm plus head injuries when blown up by a mine.
