“John LESSELS the eldest son of the above was born at RAITH in 1784, and received the most of his education from his grandmother who was highly educated and intelligent. In 1800 he was apprenticed to an agricultural implement maker in Kirkcaldy. Towards the end of his apprenticeship Mr Wm. Ferguson of Raith begged him to come to Raith and accept the position of Master Wright, in place of his grandfather who had latterly become very feeble, but as he purposed at the end of his apprenticeship commencing business on his own account he declined Mr Ferguson’s kind offer. But Mr Ferguson was anxious to secure his services, and offered to build him as new and comfortable house on the Raith Estate and gave him an annuity on his retirement which inducement led him to reverse his decision and accept the offer. In 1804 he having married Elizabeth Hamilton MURRAY went to reside with his father-in-law Mr MURRAY in Kirkcaldy until his new home at Raith was ready for his

Occupation, afterwards called the Heather Lodge.”

Elizabeth Hamilton MURRAY a daughter was born and baptised 30 April 1786 Canogate Edinburgh Scotland parents Mary SUTHERLAND and Robert MURRAY.

A researcher stated that Elizabeth’s mother was Margaret GOURLEY but her mother was Mary SUTHERLAND. Elizabeth’s death registration records her parents as Mary and Robert MURRAY the same as the above baptism. Elizabeth’s marriage registration also

gives her father as Robert MURRAY. I believe Margaret GOURLEY could have been Elizabeth's grandmother and with further research we will be able to locate the connection. The surname is spelt in various ways Gourley – Gourlay – Gourlie Gourly.

John LESSELS residing in the parish of Tolbooth Church Edinburgh a native of the parish of Abbotshall and Elizabeth Hamilton MURRAY of St Andrews Parish Edinburgh were lawfully married at Edinburgh by Principal BAIRD 30 August 1804.

“John LESSELS after diligently and honestly serving four lairds of Raith for 37 years he retired with a pension granted to him by Robert Ferguson. During the lives of 3 generations of the LESSELS family, a great friendship existed between them and the Fergusons of Raith, and when the above John LESSELS had retired he was often welcome guest at Raith and Archerfield. In 1854 whilst the writer was employed at Windsor Castle as an architect he was invited with the above (his grandfather) to visit Archerfield House where he spent some days sketching in the grounds along with his grandfather. He was highly respected both by the Fergusons, and a large number of friends, owing to his kindly and genial disposition being induced with a fund of wit and humour and fond of singing old Scotch songs and dancing Highland reels up to the age of 75. Both he and his wife enjoyed good health during their life times and were upright and possessed of their faculties. After his retirement he settled down in the Links of Kirkcaldy, but had resided for a few years previously in Regent Street Portobello, when his old friend Thomas Ronald, Wine merchant, returned to Kirkcaldy, John LESSELS also returned there where he died 3rd February 1865 aged 82, his wife dying two years afterwards aged 81.”

Abbotshall Fifeshire Scotland

Abbotshall a parish and village on the south coast of the county is in its utmost extend not more than two miles each way. Its general appearance is pleasant rising gradually from the coast northward into pretty high grounds. Raith-house, the seat of Robert Ferguson esq. Is in this parish. The village is populous and does considerable business in ticks checks & c.

Kirkcaldy Fifeshire Scotland

Kirkcaldy a royal burgh and sea-port situated on the northern shore of the Firth of Forth, in 3 miles E. of Kinghorn, 31 from Dundee, and 13 from Edinburgh. It stretches along the feet of a bank, and is properly but one street, about a mile in length, with a few narrow lanes on each side. – The town-house is a plain building with a tower and spire situated nearly in the middle of the town and the church, which is in the Gothic style, stands on an eminence at the back of the town. The harbour of Kirkcaldy is both safe and commodious. The trade has greatly increased of late; and several considerable manufactures are carried on among which are extensive ones of striped Hollands ticks, checks ^ c. with a considerable manufacture of stockings; there are likewise large tanneries with several breweries on an extensive scale. The harbour of Kirkcaldy had been greatly improved of late so much so that vessels of very considerable burden of which class many belong to the port may easily enter. The beautiful mansion of Dunikier with its surrounding pleasure grounds the scat of Sir John Oswald is well worthy of notice. The prospect from the high ground is magnificent and enlivened by the constant succession of vessels sailing up and down the Forth. The market is held on Saturday and there are fairs on the first Saturday in February, March, April, May, June and July and on the last Wednesday in September.
