Armidale Boarding House & Private Hotel - Main Road renamed Brunswick Guest House

Photographer Brian Pearce Last edited by Brian J Pearce. Description This private hotel was built in 1929 by Hannah Clark and was originally called the 'Armidale'. Part of the Maidstone Mall was later built on the site. Hannah worked very hard as the hotel had 18 rooms and she did all the washing and cooking - an almost endless job with very little time to herself; she would only have male boarders. Hannah eventually sold the hotel and later its name was changed. The last owner to operate the premises as a private hotel was Hance Brannen. This photograph was taken the day before the building was demolished; coincidentally Hannah's grandson Bernard O'Riley was the bulldozer driver. (Information supplied from the back of a colour photo supplied by Hannah's children.) The hotel appears in many photographs of the procession celebrating Upper Hutt's proclamation as a city in May 1966.



The Grand Private Hotel was built in 1926 on the corner of Camp Road and Stafford Street. The Grand Private Hotel was and later renamed the Ascot Lodge then Rifleman Bed & Breakfast Inn and finally Bell House.

The dwelling at 40 Camp Street on the corner of Stafford Street in Trentham (now zoned Silverstream) was built in 1926. On the 19 April 2015 the dwelling was described as 700m by 320 m with 9 bedrooms, 3 bathrooms, and 2 car spaces. The legal description Lot 1 Deposited Plan 58868 Valuation reference 15900/58200

Mr Jack Smith Successful Applicant - Yesterday morning the Heretaunga Licensing Committee, under the chairmanship of Mr J R Drummond, SM approved of the application for a hotel license at Trentham by Mr Jack Smith. Mr Smith is at present in conjunction with Mrs Smith proprietors of a Private Hotel in Totara Street Trentham known as Telford's Board House. The name of the new hotel will be Heretaunga if the license is confirmed by the Licensing Control Commission. Previous to the application being approved there were two applications that of Mr Smith and one under the name of Mr W L Gabites on the morning of the hearing however the latter application was withdrawn. On behalf of Mr Smith his Counsel Mr Lester pointed out to the Committee that Mr Smith was a man of business experience and held a certificate of fitness. At one time he was employed in a bottle store of a hotel also in the bar after which he was it commercial traveller then went into business on his own. **For the past 14 years Mr Smith and his wife had run the private hotel at Trentham** and had many connections with the general public and understood them. If the license was granted to him he intended to live on the premises and manage the hotel in conjunction with his wife. Mr Smith stated that his wife and himself were the **sole shareholders in Telford's Hotel and owned the land**, approximately 3 acres and the value estimated including the existing buildings not less than £15,000. In addition an option to purchase the adjoining land had been secured if so desired to improve the access and facilitate the laying out of the hotel. Continuing Mr Smith stated the existing buildings would be used to provide living quarters for the staff of the new hotel. The new hotel was estimated to cost approximately £76,000 made up as follows - Land and existing buildings £15,000, new building (architect's estimate) £46,000, furnishings £7000, license £5,800, stock £1,400. The building would be erected on contemporary lines in fire resisting materials with adequate public and private bars with a beer garden. The front of the hotel would be on Ararino Road with the whole structure on Totara Street and will also cater for the parking of 130 cars, with three entrances and exits. Mr N F Wilson the architect stated he had been practising in Wellington and his experience of hotels included the designing of the Hotel St. George, Masonic Hotel (Napier), Naenae Hotel and Kawerau Hotel. The speaker stated he had designed the new hotel at Trentham as one story on contemporary lines following the latest principles in fire resisting materials. Orientation and natural lighting also ventilation had been given every consideration and provisions had been made in the plans for future extensions. The plans provided for 15 guests in five double and five single rooms complete with adequate bathroom and lavatory accommodation in addition to the manager's suite consisting of sitting room, double bedroom and bathroom. The beer garden planned would occupy an area of land to the northwest of the new hotel and would be served from the house bar also it would have access to both ladies and gents lavatories which serve the main lounge. The figure of £46,000 would include kitchen

equipment including refrigerator and mechanical ventilation control heating and domestic hot water supply to all bedrooms and glass washing machines in all bars. Bar counter with formica and linoleum counter tops and all necessary bottle fittings. Hard tile floor to public bar and heavy lino or plastic tiles to private bar and entrances. The whole of the hotel would be centrally heated. Mr Wilson stated that tenders could be called within six months and the hotel built in 12 months. Mr J R.Drummond on behalf of the Committee stated they had heard the submissions put forward and approved of the plans and also of the applicant and wished Mr Smith well in this necessary appointment of another hotel in the district. On behalf of his client Mr Leister said he hoped the hotel would be a credit to the district. Mr Drummond I am sure it will be.
