A serious accident happened at the Upper Hutt yesterday forenoon to Mr John McIntosh, very well known in Wellington as Johnny McIntosh, at one time licenses of the New Zealander Hotel, Manners street. By the report furnished to Inspector Thomson by Constable Harnett it appears that Mr McIntosh was asked to hold a horse attached to a buggy, as the driver, wished to go into the Provincial Hotel, of which Mr Charles Cudby son-in- law to McIntosh, is licensee. McIntosh had been holding the horse for some time when something frightened it and it attempted to get away. McIntosh, in endeavouring to hold the struggling animal, got thrown down under the horses feet, with the result that his shoulder was badly broken. He was picked up immediately and carried into the hotel, and Dr Wilford, of the Lower Hutt, was telephoned for. As soon as possible the doctor was on the scene, but on examination of the injured man found he could not set the limb without putting the patient under chloroform, and it would be necessary to take him to the Lower Hutt to do so. McIntosh was put into the doctor's trap, and the pair started for the Lower Hutt. In driving round one of the gorges on the road the horse fell, and the doctor and patient were thrown out onto the road. The doctor received some severe injuries to his arm, and McIntosh fresh injuries to his shoulder, and also to his head, which Dr Wilford had then and there to bandage up. On subsequent arrival at the Hutt the doctor was so incapacitated by his injuries as to unable to deal with his patient, whom he ordered to be sent to the local hospital. The injured man was brought in by Mr James Cudby last evening. On enquiry at the Hospital this afternoon we hear Mr McIntosh is progressing as favourably as can be expected. – Evening Press

Charles Cudby - Charles Cudby, who died on the morning of 21 April 1914, at his son's residence, Petone, was born at Green Man Common, Navestock, near Bomford, Essex, England, in 1837, and on October 21 1856, sailed from Birkenhead, in the ship Martha accompanied by his wife (maiden name, Elizabeth Payne) to whom he had been married at an Anglican church near his birthplace. Arriving in Sydney in January, 1857, he left there for Wellington on 26 April and landed there on 01 May, and settled at Lower Hutt where he worked as a pit-sawyer. He removed to Upper Hutt in 1862 where he engaged in road contracting in addition to pit sawing until 1880 when he commenced business as a carpenter adding undertaking in 1910 and continuing both up to the time of his death. For some months past deceased had practically retired from active business pursuits owing to ill-health and lived on the farm at Trentham with an unnamed daughter and son. Mrs Cudby died on 20 September 1885, shortly after the birth of her youngest son, having borne fifteen children, all of whom are still living. Mr Cudby was buried at St Joseph's Upper Hutt, on 23 April, the Rev. Father L J Daly, performing the funeral ceremonies. Deceased leaves six daughters, nine sons, fifty-three grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren. The whole of the sons and daughters assembled at his funeral the only other occasion on which the fifteen were together was at Mrs Cudby's
