Fatal Accident – We are sorry to have to record the death of Mr Wm. Dew senior of Valley End Farm Hutt under the following painful circumstances. It appears that deceased was riding home from the Upper Hutt lately on Mr Giles's timber dray when about half way between Mr Barton's and the Silver Stream he fell off between the fore and hind wheels the latter passing over his body in such a manner as to cause instant death. The deceased (who was one of the earliest settlers) served in the Guards at the battle of Waterloo. He had left a wife and numerous family to deplore his untimely end

#The Late Fatal Accident in Wellington - An inquest was held at the Hospital on Thursday morning, before the Coroner, Dr Johnston, touching the death of Cornelius Croft (commonly known as Con Croft), who was killed by a runaway horse in Willis Street on Tuesday afternoon. Dr M S Grace deposed that, on hearing of the accident, he followed the injured man to the Hospital. He was insensible, and bleeding from one ear and from the mouth. Stertorous breathing had set in, and the man was suffering severely from the shock. Witness concluded that the base of his skull was fractured, and that the injury would speedily prove fatal. Next morning he learned that the man was dead. The driver of the cart, Arthur Kirby, was also called. It appeared from his evidence that the horse became restive at the noise and bustle of the crowded thoroughfare, and, getting beyond the witness's control, bolted. According to his statement, it was a young horse, very fresh, and very nervous on passing vehicles. Mr James Webber, who witnessed the accident, gave particulars similar to those already published and Mr Crook was then called to speak as to the character of the horse. He said that it was a most docile animal. The day before the accident it was frightened, owing to some of the harness being disarranged, and ran into a cab, but did no material damage.
