The bride who was given away by her brother Mr Charles Hills looked charming in a frock of white crepe de chine with in overdress of white georgette and she wore the usual veil arranged in mobcap style with wreaths of orange blossoms and carried a white shower bouquet. Miss Annie Hills sister of the bride acted as bridesmaid and wore a pretty frock of mauve crepe de chine with leghorn hat trimmed with mauve and pink and carried a shower bouquet of mauve and Pink flowers with touches of white. Mr William Hills performed the duties of best man. Afterwards the guests were entertained at the Royal Tea Rooms. The bride and bridegroom left later for Rotorua the bride wearing a champagne coloured costume with champagne coloured georgette hat underlined with pale blue.
