Patrick Brannigan, Michael Morisay, John Kitchen and John Callagan privates in the 65th regiment were indicted for having robbed John Jones on the 08th of April of one five pound note and two sovereigns. From the evidence it appeared that the prosecutor had been drinking at the house of Frances Fennel at Thorndon on the day in question in company with four soldiers who had set upon him and beat him and robbed him of his money. The evidence was conclusive against Patrick Brannigan and Michael Morisay who were sentenced to two years imprisonment and hard labour the last month in each year to be spent in solitary confinement the other two prisoners were acquitted.

We regret to have to record the death of Mr John Kitchen which took place last Saturday at his son's residence, Russell Street Feilding. Deceased arrived in this colony about 1855 with a detachment of the 66th Regiment. He joined the regiment at Portadown, County of Armagh, Ireland, on 29th January 1855, and was discharged after ten years' service at the camp, Te Awamuta, on 21st August 1865, with one good conduct badge. He served through the Maori war and saw much active service. The late Mr Kitchen in company with Mr Laurence Ormond also a 65th man assisted in working one of the first printing machines introduced into Wellington at the Advertiser office some 30 years ago. The funeral will take place tomorrow Afternoon.

Obituary - Mr W H J Kitchen - The death occurred on 08 July 1935 of a well-known resident of Feilding in the person of Mr William Henry James Kitchen of Aorangi Street Feilding in his 74th year. Deceased who was born and educated in Wellington was the only son of the late Mr John Kitchen. His early days were spent in the Johnsonville and Fitzherbert districts and later he settled in Feilding where he married Miss Sarah Towler eldest daughter of the late Mr and Mrs F. Towler who were among the first settlers in the district. He was a keen footballer in his younger days and was connected with the Feilding Sash and Door Co. for 20 years. Besides his widow there are left to mourn their loss a grown-up family of seven sons and four daughters. The funeral took place at the Feilding cemetery and the service was conducted by the Rev Mayo of Marton. The pall-bearers at the house were deceased's sons, William, Alec, Stanley, Allen, John and Raymond and at the cemetery Messrs J S Symonds, W Rosoman, W Towler, G Towler, J Garnett and D Thompson. Among the large number of floral emblems were those from the Feilding Sash and Door Co., Borthwick and Co., Horticultural Society, the Kowhai Rebekah Lodge, No. 28.
