Information of Witnesses taken touching on the death of Ellen Mudgeway

To whit Information of witnesses taken this the 30th day of April in the district of the Hutt at the dwelling house of Charles Mudgeway known by the sign of the Barley Mow in the said district before Mark Hebbell coroner for the district of Wellington touching the death of Ellen Mudgeway.

Richard Mudgeway being sworn states that he is the brother to the deceased Ellen Mudgeway states he was in the Bush and his sister the deceased bought him his dinner and she and he and another sister commenced cross cutting a log together when the tree fell on my sister Ellen and crushed her and I ran for my father I called to my sister Ellen to come towards me as she was running towards me the tree fell upon her - his X mark (witness Mark Hebbel)

Charles Mudgeway being duly sworn father of the deceased Ellen Mudgeway I was in the bush splitting rails on Saturday with my son Richd. I came out to my dinner when my son and daughter told me that the tree had fell on the deceased I ran directly to the spot I found her between two trees I took and lifted one tree off and released her I took her up and was carrying her home to my house which was a distance of about one mile and half when we was met by Mr Wyeth and my son I was so much overcome I could not get on any further I sent Mr Wyeth into the road to get assistance I sat a long time with the child in my lap until some roadmen came and carried the child home before the deceased reached home the Doctor was waiting at my house I am sure the deceased was dead when I first discovered her and the Doctor states the Childs neck was dislocated – C Mudgway

A young man named Gus Johnson courageously plunged in to save her and had succeeded in bringing her towards the bank where others were waiting to assist him when both he and the girl disappeared together and were drowned. Another respected old settler passed away at the Wellington Hospital on Thursday in the person of Mrs Charles Mudgway whose name is associated with many historic events connected with this city. Her husband Mr Charles Mudgway arrived with his parents in the ship Catherine Stuart Forbes in Wellington in June 1841 and was married here some years afterwards. They resided at Pipitea Point for many years and whilst living there the rebel natives looted their dwelling place. Afterwards Mr Mudgway removed to the Hutt where he took part in fighting the Maoris and claims to have shot the first Maori in an engagement under Lieutenant White of the 96th

Regiment. Mr Mudgway also formed part of the gang who were engaged in making the first road undertaken by the New Zealand Company – namely from Pipitea Point to Kaiwarra. His wife whose deceased we are noting was with him during his early trails, and for the last 26 years they have been living together in Porirua. We believe we are correct in stating that Mrs Mudgway who was a daughter of the late Mr Sunnex of the Hutt leaves a host of relatives, eight of her own progeny, 32 grandchildren, 50 great grandchildren, making altogether 90 descendent, not including other near relatives all of whom reside in the Wellington Provincial District. This is an excellent record.

#The Otaki Races Two Fatal Accidents – We received the following sad intelligence from our Otaki correspondence last evening – A most melancholy accident happened today at the Otaki Races in which a young man named Charles Mudgway met his death by coming in collision with some young women riding round the course. The accidents happened after the races were over reference Papers past website Manawatu Herald newspaper 23 January 1880 page 2

#The Fatal accidents at Otaki - In last Issue we were able to announce little more than the bare fact that two fatal accidents had occurred after the Otaki races. We are able now to lay further particulars before our readers. The first case is that of a man named Charles Mudgway. It appears that he was riding at a hand gallop round the course, and was met by four ladies on horseback, viz, two of the Misses McDonald of Horowhenua, Miss Jenkins of Otaki, and Miss Cameron, who was on a visit to Mr Jenkins, to whom she is related. Mudgway was riding along full tear, whilst the ladies were going along at a sharp canter. The former, being unable to guide his horse past the ladies, struck Miss Jenkins on the leg, and glanced off, meeting Miss Cameron, both horses and riders striking violently. Miss Cameron and Mudgway both fell to the ground, and the former dropping on his head, a concussion of the brain ensued from which he died in a short time. Miss Cameron was badly bruised, and was compelled to take to her bed at once, but we hear is now improving rapidly. Mudgway was until lately a resident of the Hutt. He was a stout man, 35 years of age. He was a widower, having some time since lost his wife, and by his death five children, all boys are orphaned. - #Assault – Hugh Greer was charged with unlawfully assaulting Frank Greer a little boy eight years old. Ann Greer deposed - She is the mother of complainant. Last night defendants the prisoner came into the house and hit her boy because he had run away from him. The whip produced is what he hit him with. The boy cried outside. The whip was covered with blood. His face was as it is now. There were marks also on his body. By Defendant – He had run away before. Another witness deposed that he was attracted by the cries of the little boy last night and saw defendant beating him with a whip. The boy said he had knocked his eye out. Greer said he had struck him because he had run away and defended his conduct. He was taken away. John Greer the father of the boy being sworn said in prisoners defence. The boy had been with prisoner nearly three years, and had always been held out to him to go away. - #Resident Magistrate's Court Otaki – Tuesday 12 October 1880 (Before Messrs Simcox, and Kebbell, JP's). Criminal Business - Hugh Greer was charged by Constable Mitchell with neglecting to contribute to the support of his two children, Martha and Hugh Greer, at present inmates of the Industrial School at Burnham, in Canterbury, to which they had been committed by the Otaki Justices on September 15. Constable Mitchell gave evidence in support of the charge, and stated that defendant was receiving at least 7s per day as a sawyer. Defendant said that if his children had been left at home he could have supported them, but that he could not promise to pay any specific amount per week. He was ordered to contribute 5s a week towards the maintenance of each child. The children in question were committed by Messrs Simcox and Hewson to the Industrial School, owing to being convicted of killing and stealing a fowl of the value of 2s 6d, the property of Mohi TeWharu reference Papers past website Manawatu Herald newspaper 15 October 1880 page 2

#Divorce Court – Morris v Morris - The divorce suit of Morris v Morris, the wife's petition for divorce from her husband on the grounds of cruelty and adultery, was heard before Mr Justice Richmond yesterday. Jemima Morris deposed that she was married to Thomas Wilson Morris at Wellington in March 1879. She was 13½ years old then. Four children were born of the marriage. After the ceremony the couple resided at Johnsonville for about nine years, then lived three years in the Wairarapa, and returned to Johnsonville, subsequently going to Levin. Petitioner left her husband in February 1892. He was always growling at and beating her, and he insisted on her going, and took her things to the railway station, she had only a few shillings, and so left the children with him, and herself took service at Gisborne for nearly three years. Charles Mudgway, witness's father, wrote to her from Johnsonville that her husband had married again, and she returned from Gisborne to try and get possession of the children. Respondent came down to Johnsonville, and went to see her at the residence of her niece Mrs Wm. Fisher, but her husband used such bad language that witness would not speak to him. She obtained an order from the Chief Justice for the custody of her children, and secured them. She found that her husband was living with Mary Ann Brockley. A fortnight after their marriage Morris boxed witness's ears because she would not cross a plank over a creek without his help, and he was always threatening to thrash her. About a fortnight before witness left him he slapped her because she objected to his staying out late at eight. He got drunk once or twice a week, and if she

protested would box her ears. They lived in a slab whare near the railway line, and were often short of food. There were eight of her family, all married. His Honour - Judging from your case, they went off quickly in your family. Petitioner said her father had offered a home to herself and her children. She moved to secure custody of the children as soon as she could afford to do so. Lilian Maude Morris, aged 15 years, eldest daughter of petitioner, deposed that some time after her mother's departure from Levin witness was sent by her father to Palmerston to bring Mrs Brockley a widow, down to live with them. Her father and Mrs Brockley went to Wellington to be married, her father telling witness that if she was very good he would bring home a new mother to her. A marriage feast was "kept up" at Ohau, and Mrs Brockley came back as Mrs Morris. Petitioner, recalled, said that on returning to Levin a short time back to endeavour to secure the children, she found respondent had built a better house. He was out, and Mrs Brockley, who did not know witness, told her anything she had to say had best be said to her, as she was Mrs Morris. The case was adjourned to enable the certificate of marriage to be put in.
