On Tuesday evening Mr P Quinn the well-known and popular host of the Greyhound Hotel Arahura breathed his last. Mr Quinn had been ill for some days first caught a severe cold and finally was attacked with congestion of the lungs. Dr Macandrew was called in and did all that medical science enabled him to combat the disease but without effect and he soon regarded the case as one of much gravity although he thought the sufferer would not succumb for some days. As it was the end came very quickly. Mrs Quinn was attending to her husband and in the act of making his posture more comfortable, when she found that the disease had reached a most serious stage and in a minute or two afterwards be died in her arms. In him we have lost a typical West Coaster. Frank, jovial and free hearted one of the pioneers of the Coast the prospector of Quinn's Terrace near Stafford and a man of mark at all times.
