James's may have had siblings Sophia and William Curtis both baptised in Wiltshire England to parents Rebecca and John Curtis.

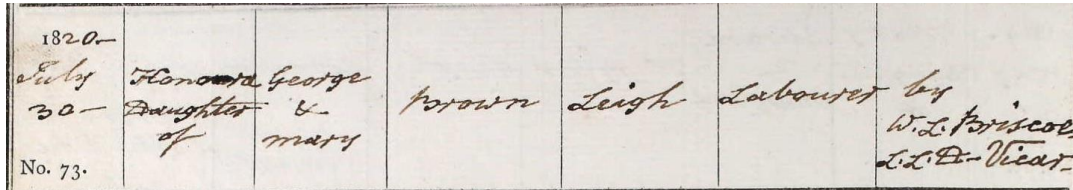

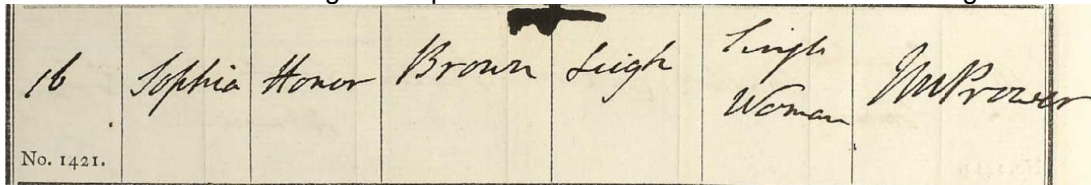

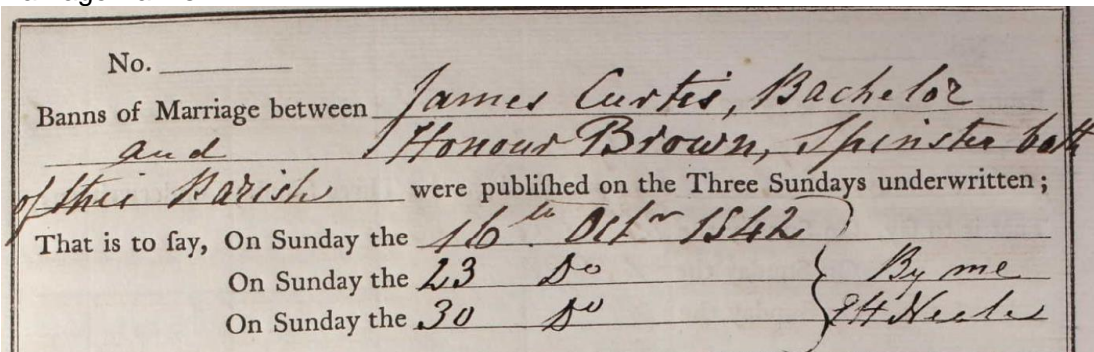
